Welcome to a brand new session. I am sure you all had a splendid summer holiday. We would be having monthly themes for this term and our theme for the month of September is 'ALL ABOUT ME'. Most of us already know our names, surnames, name of school, class and state of origin. This time, we would be learning about our country, language, flag, dressing, food, daddy's name and mummy's name e.t.c. We would also be learning about eating etiquette, grace and courtesy and so much more.

Our classroom ground rules have been laid down and most of us can now use our magic words 'please': when we want something, 'excuse me': when we want to say something or when someone is standing in our way, 'sorry': when we hurt our friends, and 'Thank you': when we want to appreciate someone.

We have also been exploring the school and the new class environment. We had a great time identifying ourselves, parts of our body, their functions and the different sizes in human being i.e tall-short, big-small.

In Numeracy, we are counting numbers 1-50 and writing numbers 1-15 according to our abilities. We are also counting objects with their associating numbers in preparation for simple addition.

In Literacy, we are reinforcing our jolly phonic sounds s, a, t, i, p, n, c, k, e, h, m, d, with their associating objects: Sun, apple, table, pencil, net, cup/kite, egg, house, mango and drum. We are also reading our alphabets A-Z

Our first creative activity was exciting as we all made colourful collage of different objects all by ourselves.

A LOOK AHEAD

It promises to be full of exciting activities. Our theme for next month (October) is ANIMALS. Our learning will be on domestic animals, their young ones, the food they eat and their homes.

We would be introduced to counting in 2(s) up to 20, counting our numbers 1-60, identifying 2D shapes. In Literacy, we would be identifying and writing our phonic sounds, we would also be introduced to blending two letter sounds. In Knowledge and Understanding the World, we would learn about Living and Non-living things. We would also do lots of practical activities to help our motor skills. We would continue with our writing skills and in Creative Art, we would be doing lots of painting.
