NEWS FROM MS TESSY'S CLASSROOM

Dear Parents, welcome to a brand new month. Sometimes it's hard to imagine how much we have learnt and changed within such a short period of time. We have a new friend (Ms Ifeoluwa) in our class and it has been great having her around, she has been of immense help to the children and would be supporting Ms Tessy.

We are gradually coming to the end of working with our Theme 'The things we wear'. The Theme has been so revealing, the children now know so much about the things they wear. Now, we know the things we wear on our head and feet (cover shoe, moccasin, clogs and lace up), head (Caps, sun hats, and beret). We have also learnt why we wear our clothes and shoes (To cover our bodies, to make us beautiful, to protect us from cold and heat, to protect our feet from dangerous objects, to keep our feet warm). We have also learnt how to care for our cap /hats- By washing, by brushing, by sunning.

We can now identify the different fabrics & their textures (cotton-soft, wool-soft, linen-hard, chiffon-soft, silk-soft, polyester-soft, nylon-soft).

In Knowledge of the World, we can now identify the pattern of clothes (Check, plain, stripes, leather, print and polka dot), we can tell when it's hot and when it's cold and also identify the clothes we wear in hot season (Loose, cotton and light clothes). In Numeracy, we are re-in forcing our numbers and are currently counting 1-100 and identifying 1-30. We are becoming better every day with our sorting and ordering of numbers and filling the missing numbers.

We are also making good progress in our French. Most of us can comfortably identify the things we wear in French. Merci Beaucoup Madame Fatouma.

For colours, we can identify 'peach' and our shapes are not left out.

We have also had fun with our phonics letters and can identify and sound the letters: l, b, f & their associating objects. More practice was also done with our 2 phonics letter words i.e at, am, an, if, it etc
