WOW, how time flies. It's hard to believe it's half term already. Thank you parents for all your involvement in our activities during the half term. The children have made remarkable and productive progress within a well prepared and stimulating environment which also engendered group bonding. There has been great progress in their motor skills such as using the scissors, colouring, running and playing games involving hand-eye coordination. Our circle time activities have also helped to develop the children's self esteem and positive feelings towards learning. Our classroom always comes alive during story time as the children listen with so much interest and enthusiasm.

We have learnt so much about our theme "farm animals". We have learnt about animals with fur- Cat and sheep, their young ones- kitten and lamb and their sounds- Cat-"meow", Sheep-"baa". We have learnt about animals on four and two legs, also looked at farm animals with feathers- Chicken and duck.

In Numeracy, our number work is emerging as we begin to understand the concept and quantity of numbers, we have taken further steps and improved in our identification of numbers 1-7. We have also learnt about more shapes- rectangle and square. Our phonics sounds have improved greatly, listening to sound "p" for pencil and "n" for net.

We have made a lot of progress in our 'Grace and Courtesy' and are learning to use our magic words more; we are learning to respond appropriately to greetings.

On care of self, we are now all aware of the importance of washing our hands regularly. sounds of a drum etc We are working on sounds 's' for 'sun' and 'a' for apple.
