As we approach the end of the term, we can say we have considerably matured. The term has been full of interesting activities and the children remained engaged and stimulated throughout.

We have made good progress with the topics on our scheme and in particular with our Theme for this term 'FARM ANIMALS'. We are having so much fun learning about different farm animals;

- *Their sounds.
- *What they eat.
- *Where they live.
- *Farm animal products.
- *Taking care of farm animals and their environment

We have all truly grown; Tireni is now crawling all over the Infant room, Desire is gearing up to join Tireni in the crawling exercise; Temisans' feet are now so strong on the ground, it's amazing how fast he has started running. Ikem, Zitara and Nariah have made tremendous progress in their communication skills and have an unquenchable thirst for language experience. They would be moving to Toddler Group 1 in September.

In Mathematical Development, we are still reinforcing numbers 1-10, primary colours and basic shapes. Most of us can identify colours; Yellow & Red as well as rote count 1-10 with little assistance.

The children have more advanced motor skills such as scribbling, running, walking on a straight line, learning to ride tricycles and playing games involving hand-eye coordination. Most of us have also learnt how to use our magic words e.g. 'Thank you', 'Please', 'Sorry', and simple greetings e.g "Good morning".
