

## NEWS FROM Ms Tessy's Classroom

Wow! The session has fast rolled by and it has been another productive and exciting term; you will agree that the children have had so much fun exploring and working with our theme 'SEASONS' and they can tell the different things we wear in Summer(HOT) and Winter(COLD).

Everyone collectively participated in making the term worthwhile and we are proud of all our achievements so far. We continue to refine our composure, work ethic and our ability to cooperate positively with each other. We would like to say a big "Thank You" to our parents; the children have had so much fun and attention from you!

In Numeracy, we are moving near perfection in counting numbers 1-150, writing 1-100, filling the missing numbers 1-50, identifying numbers 1-50, addition and subtraction of simple numbers, finding the difference in measurements of (weight-heavy and light, height-tall and short, length- long and short).

In Literacy, we are becoming better at identifying, sounding, blending, reading and writing our simple sentences with 3-phonetic letters. We are now more comfortable identifying and matching the Upper case letters to the lower case letters Aa-Zz.

Friday 5th June was 'WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY'; we learnt how to take care of our environment and how to keep it safe. We also had a great time planting our bean seeds and keeping the school environment clean.

Friday 19th June was our Fathers Day and we had the opportunity to give our dads the cards we made for them and to tell them how much we love them. The children were very excited to have their fathers bring them to school.
