Dear Parents,

Welcome to the last term of the year in Toddler Group 2, it's hard to believe the session is already almost over. We welcome our new friends (Jinhang and Osayamen) to our class; it is a pleasure to have you in Toddler Group 2. Our theme for this term is 'WEATHER' and we have learnt so much about the weather in such a short time. We have learnt to differentiate when it is sunny and rainy, we have also learnt to identify items used when it is rainy (umbrella, raincoat, rain boot, sweater, jacket) and when it is sunny (Sunglasses, loose clothes, face cap, hat e.t.c).

We can now define weather and have had lots of fun during outdoor learning, looking at the cloud and playing under the sun to feel when it is hot. We have also experienced the drizzle effect on one or two days during the last 2 weeks.

Our Communication and Language development skills are improving daily as we continue to engage in story time, singing and learning new songs and daily conversation with our friends. In Literacy, we are working on identifying our alphabets A-Z and writing the alphabets a-d, we are also perfecting our phonics skills (s,a,t,i,p,n,c,e,r).

In Numeracy, we are counting our numbers 1-100 and identifying numbers 1-20. We are also getting better at identifying our currencies (N5, N10, N20, N50, N100, N200, N500, and N1000).

We indeed are all growing very fast. We can express ourselves much better, we have all perfected our potty training and hardly require assistance in that area. Our picnic on Thursday last week was a blast, we all had fun talking about the weather, playing games, singing, dancing and sharing. Thank you dear parents for making it an exciting day for us.

LOOKING AHEAD

We would continue working on our phonic sounds and their associating objects, would continue writing our alphabets a,b,c,d, e ,f and numbers 1-10. We would also be identifying our shapes (circle, triangle, oval, diamond, star, rectangle and square) and measuring Tall and Short.

We would have lots of fun singing weather songs, identifying and making rainbows, kites and having dance sessions.
